Aloha Grade 6 Greenwave Families,

Finally, the time has arrived for us to open our doors and welcome the return of our 6th grade students to in-person learning. The pandemic put a hold on being able to implement the blended learning model we initially planned for but now, the infection rate on the Big Island is at a level acceptable for us to return our students to school. Thus, we are planning to transition our last group of students back to campus on an A/B blended learning schedule. We have already brought our 7th and 8th graders back to campus with great success.

**Beginning on March 22**, 6th graders in group A are invited back to in-person learning on campus followed by 6th graders in group B on **March 23**. All 6th graders in groups A, AX, B, and BX may physically attend school on their synchronous days and continue to learn online from home on their asynchronous days using the schedule below. **Note:** 6th grade students in these groups may choose to continue to attend their classes virtually with no change to their learning model or schedule, thus they would continue as they currently are.

**We highly encourage you to have your child attend school in person if he/she is struggling, in need of additional support, or is at risk of failing.**
