

# Kea'au Middle School School-Parent Compact 2022-2023

*This agreement outlines how the parents and school staff shall share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the State's high standards.*

## School Responsibilities

**Kea'au Middle School will:**

1. **Provide High-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards.**
2. **Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.**
  - a. Parent-Teacher conferences will be held annually during the fall of the current school year.
3. **Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.**
  - a. Parents will receive information regarding their child's progress through mid-quarter reports, and report cards sent home quarterly. Parents will also receive information regarding their child's progress upon request.
4. **Provide parents reasonable access to staff.**
  - a. Accommodations will be made to provide parents with the opportunity to meet with staff for consultation. Consultation will be made by phone or in person.
5. **Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.**
  - a. Parent's who are interested in volunteering at Kea'au Middle School, should contact the PCNC Facilitator. The PCNC Facilitator will assist parent in finding specific areas where parent is able to volunteer.
  - b. Parent's who are interested in participating or observing their child's class should contact their child's teacher.
  - c. Parents must check-in with school office before allowed on campus.
6. **Provide parents opportunities to participate in decisions relating to the education of their child and positive use of extra-curricular time.**
7. **Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and to the extent practicable, in a language family members understand.**

## Parent Responsibilities

- ❖ Check my child's home/school notebook on a daily basis.
- ❖ Respect and support school rules and the student code of conduct.
- ❖ Promptly read all notices from the school or the school district received by my child, email or postal mail and responding as appropriate.

- ❖ Establish a time and place for homework and be available to discuss and help.
