- 2) Secretary's Report
 - a. Meeting Minutes: This is the first meeting of the school year.
 - b. New members: Elise Pratt-Parent, Janean Stone-Alternate Parent, Teachers: David Pavel and Kristel Meyers and student Liam Albano voted on the board unanimously.
- 3) Title 1 Report –Presented by Randi Saplan Title 1 Coordinator & Resource Teacher. Requirements to be title stay that 47.2% students have free and reduced. All of our students are receiving free lunch regardless of income due to a special program. So now there is a calculation that puts us at 92% eligible where previously it was around 85%. Funds are used for student academics school wide. Funds support Mrs. Saplan's position and she also does training. A new position is being approved for a teacher in the ALC. This AELC is addressing behavior and academic issues. Previously had PTTs coverage is not available when they are out and the PTT is not credentialed. The AELC is one period during the day for whatever subject they are needing help with credit recovery. Some of the other items funds used for classroom supplies, parent involvement, PPTs and PTTs. Mrs. Saplan asked for input anytime for how to spend the Title 1 funds.

At the end of last school year the percentage of students who were not absent 90.53% in KKP. This equates to an average of 492 students absent on a given day. Focus is now on chronic absenteeism (8.5% in school year or 15+ days in school year). EO year last year KMS was 34.7% of students are chronically absent. State average is 15% chronically absent goal is 9%. 2020. Our community has many barriers: high poverty, crime rate, domestic violence, low levels of education, unemployment, poor infrastructure. By 8th grade attendance is a better predictor of graduating than standardized tests. Challenge Five started at a school in Michigan and they have 2 concepts to success: 1) Disrupt the Status Quo. 2) Establish a new normal.
 - School Safety: Stan Gapol inquired on behalf of a Community Safety
 Committee he is on about school safety in light of recent gun violence.
 KMS has mandatory lockdown, shelter in place drills and recently had a
 Vulnerability Assessment with State Office of Safety.
